Sunday Worship Update

Dear Friends,

As you probably know, the metrics are in our favor in Prince Williams County, and with more and more of us getting vaccinated, we are hoping to be able to regather indoor for worship some time soon. There are some necessary repairs and cleaning in the sanctuary that have to be addressed first, and then we will need to have a reopening plan approved by the Diocese. We are hoping to reach this stage in early/mid June – before the big summer heat!

In order to be able to keep safe distancing and limit the risk of infection, our intention is to have two services: one spoken Rite One Eucharist or Morning Prayer early in the morning, and then the main service Rite Two Eucharist with music (if no congregational singing). This service will be live streamed.

Until then, we will continue to record the service and to worship outside, weather permitting! As to relieve the volunteers who have been on duty so far, we would like to invite you to gather at 9:30am so everyone can help with the set up (as far as your physical condition allows): Rolling out the altar and tables, placing the chairs and so on. The more people we are, the lightest the task will be! That would also be the time to make yourself known if you want to help with the indoor regathering plan.

Please consider giving us a hand in the weeks to come!


